

INSTALLATION OF THE PSI FIXED ASSET SYSTEM

For this version, updates are available through our web site or via an update CD.

WINDOWS 98, 2000, ME, XP, VISTA, 7 - PERFORM ALL STEPS IN THIS SECTION

INSTALLING THE UPDATE FROM CD

- Exit all other programs and place the CD into your CD drive.
 - o If the installation does not start automatically, perform this step [Select RUN from the START menu then enter D:\setup (assuming your CD drive is D) and click OK].
- When the “PSI Fixed Asset Setup Wizard” screen appears, click the NEXT button.
- When the “Folder:” box appears, it should contain the location of your current PSIFA programs. The default is: **C:\psifa** If this is not correct, browse on your hard disk to find the correct directory. Once the “Folder:” contains the correct drive / directory, click the NEXT button.
- Click the “INSTALL” button if you wish to install the programs to the default location.
- On the next screen, click the “INSTALL” button to begin the copy process.
- When complete, click the “FINISH” button.
- The new PSIFA programs are now installed and may be accessed from the PSI icon.
- HELP screens provide detailed instructions on the use of the PSI Fixed Asset System. To access HELP while running the PSI Fixed Asset System, click the HELP button.

- Select RUN from the START menu then enter D:\copydoc (assuming your CD drive is D and that you Fixed Asset programs are located at C:\psifa) and click OK.

 - o MANUAL.PDF

INSTALLING THE UPDATE FROM OUR WEB SITE

- Through your Internet browser, go to our web site at <http://www.prosystems.com>, from the Main Page click on Support / Updates, from the Support page click on Pro Systems Fixed Asset System and continue with the steps below.
- This document is the Installation Instructions (FAU4177.PDF) that may be downloaded from our web site.
- Download the update (FAU4177.EXE) onto your computer system. Be sure to remember where you save it.
- This file is password protected and you must have a current support plan with Pro Systems to obtain a password. If you do not know the password, please contact our support department at 800-849-0001 or email mary@prosystems.com to obtain the password.
- Double-click on the update file from your hard drive to unzip the update files. The update files will be stored on your hard drive in the temporary directory C:\FA4TEMP.
- From the directory C:\FA4TEMP, double click on the program SETUP.MSI to start the update. When the "PSI Fixed Asset Setup Wizard" screen appears, click the NEXT button.
- When the "Folder:" box appears, it should contain the location of your current PSIFA programs. The default is: **C:\psifa**. If this is not correct, browse on your hard disk to find the correct directory. Once the "Folder:" contains the correct drive / directory, click the NEXT button.
- Click the "INSTALL" button if you wish to install the programs to the default location.
- On the next screen, click the "INSTALL" button to begin the copy process.
- When complete, click the "FINISH" button.
- The new PSIFA programs are now installed and may be accessed from the PSI icon.

- Once finished, the update has been completed. Once you install the documentation files as detailed below, delete the temporary directory C:\FA4TEMP and all files stored in this directory (**BE CAREFUL**).

INSTALLING THE TRUETYPE TAX FONTS

If Form 4562 does not print properly, the True Type tax fonts were most likely not automatically installed when you printed the form. When fonts are not installed, the alphabetic characters on the form appear as symbols. Try clicking the Reinstall Fonts button on the 4562 report screen. If the form still does not print properly, you can try installing the fonts manually.

To install the fonts manually, locate the file TAXFONT0.MSI in the folder where PSI Fixed Assets is installed, and double-click it. Windows may display the file as simply TAXFONT0.

Once you have installed the fonts, try printing the form again. If you are still having problems, open the Fonts folder on your computer (available from Control Panel) and remove any tax fonts that may be installed. First, locate these fonts:

Nelco Symbols
OCR-A BT
TxFont06N
TxFont08B
TxFont08N
TxFont10B
TxFont12B
TxFont14B

It is possible that another application has installed fonts with similar names, so be sure that the font names you are uninstalling match the ones on the list. Pay particular attention to OCR-A BT. All fonts will have a TT icon.

If any of these fonts are shown, hold down the Control (Ctrl) key and click each font with the left mouse button. Then, with the fonts selected, press the Delete key. Click Yes when asked if you are sure you want to delete the fonts.

Then try installing the fonts again by double-clicking the TAXFONT0.MSI file in the PSI Fixed Assets program folder.

NEW FEATURES IN THIS RELEASE (since 04.1.64)

Luxury Auto limits have been updated for 2009.

PSI Fixed Assets can now be run with Data Execution Prevention (DEP) turned on. DEP is a security feature that is normally turned on for the Windows operating system only, but it can be turned on for all programs.

PSI Fixed Assets has been updated to reflect the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009. The changes are primarily an extension of the features implemented for the Economic Stimulus Act of 2008, including 50% special depreciation allowance (asset type 3), increased luxury auto limits, and increased IRC Section 179 expense limit and cutoff (threshold) amount.

A performance feature has been added that speeds up display of the splash screen and main window. To use this feature, select Preferences on the Tools menu and check "Scale back visual effects for better performance."

It is now possible to stop PSI Fixed Assets from checking to see if tax fonts are installed before printing form 4562. On some computers, the program is not able to determine that the fonts are installed; to stop PSI Fixed Assets from repeatedly installing tax fonts, check the box on the form 4562 report screen that says "Do not check to see if tax fonts are installed."

NEW FEATURES IN THIS RELEASE (since 04.1.47)

The 2008 Form 4562 and 2007 Form 4562-FY were implemented. Form 4562-FY is generated for companies with a fiscal tax year, that is with a tax year beginning in 2007 and ending before 12/31/2008, only when the special depreciation allowance is claimed (using asset type 3). The only difference between the 2007 Forms 4562 and 4562-FY appears to be the description in line 14.

Images are now allowed on asset notes. Thumbnails of the images appear on the asset edit screen.

Tax font installation for form 4562 has been simplified. The fonts are now located on a Windows Installer file TAXFONT0.MSI. If fonts are not automatically installed when you print the form, try double-clicking this file.

Luxury auto and IRC 179 Expense limits have been updated.

Journal entries can now be exported in a format usable by Data Plus accounting software.

PSI Fixed Assets has been updated to reflect the Economic Stimulus Act of 2008 (ESA08). Under this act, you can take 50% special depreciation allowance (bonus) depreciation for assets purchased and placed in service in 2008 (use asset type 3). ESA08 also includes higher luxury auto and IRC 179 expense limits and a higher IRC 179 expense threshold (cutoff) amount.
